

PROPOSED PRICE FOR SESSION PROCEEDINGS 2019 SESSION

As determined by the Print and Mail Bureau, there will not be a price increase in the 2017 printing cost of .051 per impression. Based on the amount of printing last session and the number of anticipated subscriptions, I propose that the cost for legislative proceedings remain the same. The number of paid subscribers for a full set of bills decreased from 11 to 10, there were 6 paid subscribers for House and Senate Journals. We anticipate these numbers to remain the same or very similar, which will cover the cover the cost of a subscription adequately.
