The Board of County Printing proposes to amend one rule concerning maximum pricing and printing standards for county legal advertising. The Board proposes to raise the price of county legal advertising to address production-related costs for newsprint and postage. In addition, the Board of County Printing proposes to delete references to 6-point font to allow the use of 8-point font, which the Board believes is easier to read for the aging demographic of print advertising. The Board also proposes to update the rule for grammar and consistency
