

- 404 preschool-aged children and their families

- Governed by a Board of Directors and an elected Policy Council – parents & community reps





PY 2018-2019 Demographics

- 83% low-income (less than 200% FPL)
 - 58% of families are 100% or less FPL
 - Two foster/kinship (6%); one homeless
- 36% minority (American Indian, Latino, Asian, Biracial/multiracial)
- Approximately 12% special needs
 - Generally increases over the program year as needs are identified
- 61% are two-parent homes
