SOUTHWEST REGION PLAN AMENDMENTS Gallatin, and Butte/Silver Bow Counties

The following amendments were adopted:

Plan 300

Butte/Silver Bow County - The boundary between proposed districts 60 and 61 was moved east to Little Basin Creek Road and further south to Basin Creek. Also, approximately 49 persons were moved from 61 into 60 between Utah and Foothill streets.

There were also 104 persons between Platinum and Gold Streets and Jackson and Montana Ave moved into proposed district 63 from proposed district 61, and 15 persons north of I-15 west of Butte moved into proposed district 61 from 63.

Gallatin County - The Belgrade proposed district 56 is moved closer to Bozeman using parts of proposed districts 55 and 57. The southern boundary is now Huffine, the eastern boundary is Jackrabbit, and the western boundary is approximately Flandersmill (former proposed 55 northwest boundary). The northern boundary is Weaver north of Belgrade. The Manhattan area west of Gibson Creek is now taken from proposed district 50 and placed in with proposed district 57, the Three Forks area.
